LIST OF CONDITIONS

PRODUCE PERMIT - MOBILE CANTEENS / CARTS

Please be advised that while your Produce Permit # _____ is approved, the following conditions apply to this permit.

1. The use of the parking meter zones is restricted while commercial businesses are opened; however, the City does not object to your using the meter zones after 9:00 p.m
2. There is to be no interference with vehicle and pedestrian traffic in and around parks, sport fields, etc.
3. Your mobile is to be equipped with litter baskets so that paper wrappings, etc. can be properly disposed of and not create a nuisance to City streets and public property
4. When on a City street, your mobile canteen is to be in such a manner that it does not interfere with access to existing buildings, pedestrian and/or vehicle traffic, block access or visibility onto the street
5. There is to be no violations of concessions in the City's park areas. A number of parks and sport fields have these concessions areas and these people have agreements with the City which must not be violated
6. This is the City of Corner Brook's approval and should other approvals be required from provincial authorities such as the Department of Health and Environment, etc. you are responsible to obtain their approvals
7. Should the vehicle be parked in a residential area, a commercial vehicle parking permit must be obtained
8. The City reserves the right to revoke this approval should problems arise with your operations
9. Must have a 5lb type fire extinguisher situated so as to be immediately available in case of fire
