PURPOSE

To reduce the costs concerning public notices, particularly regarding applications made under the City By-Laws, Municipal Plan and Development Regulations

POLICY STATEMENT

Whereas under the City of Corner Brook's Development Regulations 1994, applications involving variances, discretionary uses and general discretion of Council, require that the applicant give notice of an application for a permit, or outline planning permission by public advertisement in a newspaper circulating in the area or by any other means deemed necessary, City Council adopts the following policy.

DETAILED ACTION REQUIRED

- Step 1 The applicant must pay a fee of \$130.00, HST included (to be amended from time to time) to offset the charge for advertisement which is required to be placed in the local newspapers.
- Step 2 The City of Corner Brook shall prepare the advertisement and the type and size shall be appropriate for the ad.
- Step 3 Advertisements shall be placed in the local Western Star and Humber Log in their Wednesday's edition.
