PURPOSE

The purpose of this statement is to deal with the placement of temporary signs on City Property.

POLICY STATEMENT

The City of Corner Brook will permit temporary signs to be placed on City property for charity, organizations, or community services related activities. Signs for private advertising will not be permitted. Company logos identified on the signs as sponsors will be excluded.

DEFINITIONS

A "temporary sign" for the purpose of this policy is defined as a sign or banner erected for the identification of an event for a charity or community service organization.

DETAILED ACTION REQUIRED

- 1. Approval from the Community Services Department will be required prior to the erection of any sign.
- 2. Applications may be required to include a copy of the sign being erected.
- 3. Signs will not be permitted within the City street right of way under any circumstances.
- 4. Banner type signs may be permitted to overhang the City right of way.
- 5. Banners must be located in a safe, hazard free position and must be placed 18 ft.above street level so as not to cause a visibility problem for motorists or pedestrians.
- 6. The banner must be checked on a daily basis to ensure it is properly secured.
- 7. All signs must be erected in such a manner that they do not obstruct or impede pedestrian and/or traffic flow.
- 8. Signs as specified may be placed 7 days prior to the event and removed not later than 7 days following the event but in no case be placed longer than 30 days unless otherwise authorized.
- 9. The City of Corner Brook will not accept any responsibility for any costs or damages as a result of the placing of the signs.

TEMPORARY SIGNS ON CITY LAND

- 1. Coordination for the placing of the signs must be through Recreation Liaison.
- 2. The maximum size of any sign shall be 8 ft. x 8 ft.
- 3. As owners of the property, the City reserves the right to refuse the placement of any sign.
