## **PURPOSE**

Toll Booth type fundraisers that requires the interruption of traffic flow on city streets are becoming more popular. These types of fundraisers pose difficulties with respect to traffic flow and public safety and should be limited to private property.

## **POLICY STATEMENT**

Toll Booth fundraisers shall not be permitted on city-streets or property. Toll Booth fundraisers shall not be permitted on private property where city streets, traffic flow or pedestrian traffic may be affected (i.e. intersections). Toll Booth fundraisers may be permitted where the event is contained entirely on private property and with the property owner's consent. A permit is required to be obtained from the Community Services Department for the event.
