PURPOSE

This policy shall provide the City of Corner Brook with a standard for the installation and maintenance of street regulatory and informational signs. Under Section 188 and 189 of the Highway Traffic Act, the Council of the City of Corner Brook may make regulations to establish speed limits, no parking zones, establish traffic movements and/or other regulations controlling the use and operation of motor vehicles within the boundaries of the City of Corner Brook. The City utilizes traffic and roadside signs to inform the general public of the established traffic regulations as well as road hazards and general route information.

POLICY STATEMENT

Council shall adopt and approve new regulatory conditions and permanent sign locations in the City of Corner Brook.

1. All signs and sign placement, including signs for temporary conditions, shall conform to the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Design for Canada" - latest edition - unless revised by this policy or Provincial legislation.
2. All signs shall be kept clear and legible and in the proper position at all times. Damaged or missing signs shall be repaired or replaced as soon as possible. Traffic signs and supports shall not bear any unauthorized community advertising, labels, logos, etc.
3. All non-essential signs are to be removed.
4. Before any new road, detour, or temporary route is opened to traffic, all essential signs must be in place.
5. To ensure adequate maintenance a sign inventory shall be maintained, and a suitable inspection and cleaning schedule established.
