Purpose:

To ensure the removal of trees due to age, disease, damage or other reasons as determined by the Recreation Liaison or designate are replaced.

Policy Statement:

Where appropriate and practical each tree removed from City owned and/or administered property, will be replaced by a new tree in accordance with the Tree Planting Policy.

If it is deemed impractical to place a tree at the location of the felling, then an alternate location will be selected as close to the original location as possible or in a proximal public park or open space.

It is the policy of the City of Corner Brook that every reasonable attempt will be made to ensure the longevity of each protected tree. A tree will be removed only when it is deemed absolutely necessary by the Recreation Liaison or designate.




