

## A Proclamation of Landscape Architecture Day April 26, 2017

**WHEREAS**, The Atlantic Provinces Association of Landscape Architects (APALA) is the professional organization that regulates the profession of landscape architecture in PE, NS, NS and NL;

**WHEREAS**, The scope of the landscape architecture profession encompasses the design of anything imaginable in the space around, between, or even on top of buildings, to transform the face of urban and rural spaces in Atlantic Canada and around the globe;

WHEREAS, There is a growing appreciation of the work done by landscape architects who serve an important role in environmental protection by designing and implementing projects that respect the needs of people and of the environment while ensuring health, safety, and welfare of the public; and

WHEREAS, International professional associations representing landscape architecture have joined together to honour the profession in April, a month notable for Earth Day (April 22<sup>nd</sup>) and the birthday of Frederick Law Olmsted (April 26<sup>th</sup>), founder of the landscape architecture profession in North America.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that,** I, Mayor Pender, on behalf of City Council, do hereby proclaim April 26, 2017 as "Landscape Architecture Day" in the City of Corner Brook.
