Municipal Engineer

The City of Corner Brook is presently accepting applications for the permanent position of **Municipal Engineer** with the Department of Community, Engineering, Development & Planning (Engineering Division). This position will report to the Manager of Engineering Services and will provide technical advice to all departments when requested, administer engineering services for the capital works and maintenance projects, and liaise with consulting engineers and contractors.

Responsibilities: Major duties will include providing technical advice and guidance to municipal staff, developers, and contractors on the application of municipal regulations and good engineering principles for construction carried out within the Municipality. The successful candidate will act as a resource person on technical/engineering matters for the City while maintaining an up-to-date knowledge of the field; review engineering plans and designs for adherence to municipal regulations, plan specifications, and good engineering practices for construction carried out within the Municipality; and, assist in the preparation of the City's annual and long term operational and capital budgets. The municipal engineer will work closely with the Manager of Engineering Services to ensure effective control over expenditures of the Engineering Division and the administration and design of capital works projects to ensure that the work is carried out in accordance to specifications, including preparation of progress payment certificates, progress reports, and other contract documentation. The municipal engineer may be required to respond to media requests, which may include television and/or radio interviews. A minimum of a Bachelor's degree in civil engineering from a recognized post-secondary institution with 5 plus years progressive experience, preferably in a municipal environment.
