WELDER

The City of Corner Brook is currently accepting applications for the permanent, full-time, position of Welder with the Department of Public Works, Water & Wastewater.

The Welder reports to the Mechanical Foreman or their designate and will be required to carry out various welding related tasks including, but not limited to, welding, heating, tapping, and cutting all types of ferrous and no-ferrous metals. On occasion the welder will be required to carry out duties at outdoor work sites where the work environment is subject to differing weather conditions, various heights, confined spaces, and/or working around live sewer.

Duties will include (not inclusive) cutting all types of metals using gas cutting torches, electric and cutting tools, hand held or bench grinders, and drills. Assisting in the development of repair estimates. Conducting Technical Inspections relating to welding integrity. Operating various machinery such as a welding truck and a diesel-powered welding generator, an overhead crane, hydraulic engine lift, and other types of motorized equipment operated by the City for repair purposes. All other duties related to the position as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must be fully certified as a Journeyman Welder as recognized by the province of Newfoundland and Labrador and possess a valid class 5 NL driver's license.
