### PURPOSE

To establish a policy with respect to the placement of Children at Play signs in the City of Corner Brook.

### POLICY STATEMENT

The City of Corner Brook often receives requests to install signs on City of Corner Brook rights-of-ways to warn drivers of the possible presence of children.

The City of Corner Brook realizes that signs attempting to warn motorists of normal conditions fails to achieve the desired response, and Children at Play signs also tend to create a false sense of security for parents and children. The use of Children at Play signs is not recognized by the Transportation Association of Canada and the City of Corner Brook agrees to comply with the standards set by Transport Canada.

"Children at Play" and other similar signs will not be installed on residential streets in the City of Corner Brook.
