POLICY STATEMENT

- 1. All requests for erection of sign(s) for hearing and/or visually impaired children shall be referred to t he Director of Operational Services.
- 2. The Director of Operational Services shall arrange to have the hearing and/or visually impaired sign(s) erected at the earliest opportunity, in accordance with the policy. For information purposes, the Operational Services Policy Advisory Committee shall also be informed of any new sign(s) erected.
- 3. Hearing and/or visually impaired sign(s) are to be placed on the street, in close vicinity of the house (150-200 meters, either side if practical), where a visually and/or hearing impaired child resides. Actual location dependent on site conditions.
- 4. Families of hearing and/or visually impaired children have the responsibility of notifying the Director of Operational Services, in writing, if they move residence. In the event that the family relocates, and advises the City accordingly, the hearing and/or visually impaired sign(s) will be moved at the earliest opportunity; however, signs will not be relocated during the winter months
