## How to Adopt a Hydrant:

2. Fill out the form and mail it back to the City of Corner Brook, P.O. Box 1080, Corner Brook, NL A2H 6E1, Attn: Adopt a Hydrant Program.

Or

3. Call 709-637-1666 and provide your name, hydrant number, telephone number, and email address.

Then, clear your hydrant after a snowfall, or if it is heavily covered in snow.

Please ensure there is a 3 ft. clearing around your hydrant at all times. Please be extra vigilant after heavy snowfall. Firefighters will be checking hydrants regularly to ensure safe clearance.

Once you register, and you maintain a snow-cleared hydrant, your name will be entered for the grand prize draw!
