The City of Corner Brook is a progressive, modern organization with approximately 300 employees divided amongst four main departments (Finance & Administration, Engineering, Development & Operational Services, Protective Services and Recreation & Tourism Services). Located on the West Coast of the province of Newfoundland & Labrador, Corner Brook is the largest urban centre outside of the Avalon Peninsula.

The City of Corner Brook is presently accepting applications for the position of **Director of Engineering, Development & Operational Services (EDOS)**. This position is a six-month temporary position with the possibility of extension. As a member of the senior management team, the Director of EDOS reports to the City Manager and is responsible for oversight of the EDOS department. The Director is responsible for overseeing infrastructure maintenance, snow clearing, water and wastewater, engineering, and development and planning services.

The incumbent must have a solid understanding of developing, overseeing, and managing a budget as well as managing both unionized and nonunionized staff.

The Director of EDOS is responsible for providing knowledgeable, effective leadership across all City delivered infrastructure and operational services. This includes oversight of engineering functions, public works operations, water and wastewater treatment and distribution/collection systems, municipal development standards and permitting processes, snow clearing operations, and the planning and delivery of construction projects. The Director ensures that staff are supported, service levels are maintained, and operational challenges are addressed promptly and professionally to meet the needs of residents and the organization.

The successful candidate will liaise with multiple levels of government, community members, and other stakeholders regarding the delivery of operational activities.

This position requires strong people management and human resource management skills. The Director will ensure employees are recruited, trained, and appraised and that all human resource management issues and concerns are addressed in a timely and procedurally correct manner.

To be successful in this role the applicant should have a combination of the below:

- 10 years of progressively advancing management experience, preferably in a complex multi-disciplined environment
- A Professional Engineer with a license to practice in NL
- Exceptional conflict management, negotiation, decision making, analytical, and leaderships skills
- A solid understanding of Human Resources and Finance



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- Experience with Project Management
- A sound understanding of key legislative and regulatory requirements that apply to the Department of EDOS (municipal, provincial, and federal) and be able to ensure all legal and regulatory requirements are met
- Ability to work irregular hours and travel as required.
