The ideal candidate will assist with organizing, planning, and developing products and/or events in conjunction with the Supervisor of Tourism and the Tourism Assistant to ensure an outstanding customer service and quality guest experience. This position will also fill in on the Mill Whistler Train on an “as required” basis or in the absence of the Tour Guide.

The successful applicant must meet the eligibility for funding under the Canada Summer Jobs Program. Applicants must be between 15 to 30 years of age at the start of employment. Applicants must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act for the duration of the employment. The successful candidate must have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.
